EUROPEAN BOARD EXAMINATION IN UROLOGY ORAL EXAMINATION 2018 - SCORING SYSTEM

General: The candidate's mark in the EBU Online Written Examination varies between 6 and 9.

Oral examination: Each case scores on a 1 – 4 scale. The following items are judged and scored:

	Poor	←————→			Excellent	Absolute failure
Diagnostic Acumen (history, exam, tests)	1	2	3	4		0
Clinical Judgement (what to do?)	1	2	3	4		0
Therapy (how to do it?)	1	2	3	4		0

0 (zero) = dangerous response = absolute failure

Scoring per clinical case per candidate:

- Score = 3 – 12.

After 3 cases the overall score per candidate is determined:

- Maximum score = 36.
- Passing score = 24, without an absolute failure.

The marks are transcribed on a 1 - 10 scale as follows:
