**EUROPEAN BOARD EXAMINATION IN UROLOGY
ORAL EXAMINATION - SCORING SYSTEM**

The candidate's mark in the **EBU Online Written Examination** varies between 6 and 9.

In the **EBU Oral Examination** 4 cases are presented and each case scores on a 1 – 4 scale. The following items are judged and scored:

- Diagnostic Acumen: History, exam, tests.
- Clinical Judgement: What to do?
- Therapy: How to do it?

Scoring per clinical case per candidate:

- Score = 3 – 12.

After 3 cases the overall score per candidate is determined:

- Maximum score = 36.
- Passing score = 24.

Scoring is done by the 2 examiners independently and the final score is the average.

The marks are transcribed on a 1 - 10 scale as follows:
