EUROPEAN BOARD EXAMINATIONS IN UROLOGY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

FEBU Written Examination

- Final year residents being trained in a UEMS/EBU member country.
- Board certified urologists.

FEBU Oral Examination

- Final year residents being trained in a UEMS/EBU member country.
- Board certified urologists:
 - Those holding a national board certificate issued in a UEMS/EBU member country.
 - Those holding a national board certificate issued outside a UEMS/EBU member country must have passed the FEBU written examination in, or before, 2008.

Required documents/proof of status

- Final year residents have to submit proof of being in the final year of training, stating that the urological training programme consists of minimum five years (statement signed by PD).
- Residents from United Kingdom and Ireland need to be on an official training programme; applicants trained in the United Kingdom must indicate their national training number on the statement.
- Board certified urologists must submit a copy of the national board certificate and may additionally be requested to provide proof of having completed a urological training programme of minimum five years.
