The test consists of 10 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs):

- a. Each MCQ has only one correct answer, which can be chosen out of the four alternatives. *For certain questions, more than one response may appear to be correct. In such cases, choose the one best response.*
- b. We advise you to answer all MCQs; you are better off guessing than leaving the question unanswered.

Starting the assessment

1. Click on the link : Online Demo Test
2. Enter your user name : ebu
3. Enter your password : ebu
4. Click the button Login
5. Click the button : Select Test
6. Select : Online Demo Test

Taking the assessment

7. To start click  (on the right side of the bottom tool bar)

8. To proceed, **click one of the following buttons** on the right side of the bottom toolbar:



Test Overview

View the status of the questions.

Questions answered : you may choose to change the answer

Question unanswered : you may still choose the one best answer

This button also allows you to select any of the 10 questions very easily.



Previous question

Go back to the previous question(s) any time during the assessment. You will have the option to change the answer.



Next question

Go to the next question.

Finishing the assessment



Stop

Upon completing the 10 questions, click the **STOP** button. Confirm ending the assessment by clicking **OK**.

Results

The next screen will show you your test results; please note that these are preliminary. You may not review the questions.

The Question Overview indicates which of the questions were answered correctly or incorrectly.

Click the **Exit** button to shut down.

- a) Consult the bottom toolbar to monitor your progress on the number of questions and the remaining time. A message will appear when the assessment time has expired.
