## EUROPEAN BOARD EXAMINATIONS IN UROLOGY

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

---

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

An applicant registering for the FEBU Written Examination meets one of the following criteria:

- Final-year resident being trained in a UEMS/EBU member country;
- Certified urologist.

#### REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- Individual online registrations have to be completed through the EBU's online registration system before the indicated deadline.
- The registration must be completed by the **participant ONLY**.
  - Online registrations done directly by third parties (i.e. a sponsoring company) will not be processed to minimize incomplete or inaccurate information.
  - In case the examination fee is paid by a sponsoring company, the participant fills out the company's contact details in the respective debtor fields before completing the online registration.
  - The original invoice is sent directly to the debtor/sponsoring company; a copy is forwarded to the participant along with the registration confirmation.

#### CANCELLATION PROCEDURE

- In case of a cancellation, the EBU Office should be duly notified in writing. A general cancellation fee of € 30 is charged.
- Failure to pay the participant's fee before the indicated deadline will lead to a cancellation by the EBU Office. A general cancellation fee of € 30 is charged.
- Cancelled registrations are not automatically carried over to the next examination year.
- There is no refund given in case the written cancellation notice is received less than a week before the scheduled examination date.
- In exceptional circumstances the Board may decide to deviate from the aforementioned procedures.
