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Certification criteria

An EBU-EAU Certified Host Centre practices a multidisciplinary approach to the treatment of one of the urological fields mentioned above.

Furthermore, an EBU-EAU host centre should meet the following general criteria:

- Work in line with the [EAU Guidelines](#).
- Have an [adequate number of cases](#) to maintain a high level of results and to provide a comprehensive and practical training in the given specialty.
- Be adequately equipped and have access to supporting specialties.
- Employ at least two consultants who are experts in the field.
- Demonstrate that it has a structured programme to allow the fellow to gain knowledge and expertise in the field.
- Publish own results.
- Be involved in scientific or clinical research and support the fellow to participate.
