PART 2 ORAL EXAM SCORING SYSTEM

Independent scoring

- Both Examiner and Trustee score independently; they each fill out a score form for each of the 3 cases.
- The secretariat processes the score forms.

General

The candidate's mark in the EBU Written Examination varies between 6 and 9.

Oral examination

Each case scores on a 1 – 4 scale. The following items are judged and scored:

	Poor	←→		Excellent
Diagnostic Acumen (history, exam, tests)	1		2 3	4
Clinical Judgement (what to do?)	1		2 3	4
Therapy (how to do it?)	1		2 3	4

Scoring per clinical case per candidate:

- Score = 3 – 12.

After 3 cases the overall score per candidate is determined:

- Maximum score = 36.
- Passing score = 24.

The marks are transcribed on a 1 - 10 scale as follows:

Score	≤ 17	18 - 20	21 - 23	24 - 26	27 - 29	30 - 32	≥ 33
Mark	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
