General

The candidate's mark in the Part 1 Written Exam varies between 6 and 9.

Oral exam

Each case scores on a 1 – 4 scale based on the following 3 factors.

	Poor ←————→ Excellent			
Diagnostic Acumen: History, exam & tests.	1	2	3	4
Clinical Judgement: What to do.	1	2	3	4
Therapy: How to do it.	1	2	3	4

Scoring per clinical case per candidate.

- Score = 3 – 12.

The exam is based on minimum 3 to maximum 5 cases and depending on the number of cases the overall score is determined.

3 cases

- Maximum score = 36.
- Passing score = 24.

The marks are transcribed on a 1 - 10 scale.
