FEBU Part 2 Oral Exam 2022

General information

Date	Monday 27 June 2022.
Time	Between 07:30 and 20:00 hrs. CET.
Venue	Warsaw, Poland. Details are announced in April.
Format	Pre-recorded exam.
Set-up	Taken at a PC provided by us.
Sessions	8 consecutive sessions. Each session lasts on average 60 minutes.
Case reports	The candidate is presented between 3 to 5 cases. A different set of cases is used in the morning and afternoon.
Exam session	The candidate receives personalized information about the time of his/her session, including detailed instructions on the exam procedure, in May.

Exam procedure

Registration	On the day of the exam the candidate registers at the assigned time and place based on information provided beforehand.
Mobile devices	The use of mobile devices is not allowed in the rooms and must be left, and collected afterwards, with the EBU staff.
Exam room	In the hotel we set up exam rooms with a PC. The candidate is guided to the assigned exam room by a host.
Exam	The candidate takes the exam under supervision of one examination board member. Once logged in to the computer the exam starts automatically. The candidate is presented the pre-recorded content verbally and is guided to give a verbal response to a specific question. The responses are given in the same language.
Confidentiality	Candidates of the first 3 morning & afternoon are sequestered until the last morning/afternoon session has started.

Evaluation & results

Evaluation	The candidate is evaluated independently by a minimum of two examination board members. One examination board member completes the evaluation onsite, while the other evaluation is performed online after the exam. Some candidates may be subjected to a third review.
Marking	Based on the scoring system published on our website.
Announcement results	The candidate is informed by email before the end of September.
FEBU diploma	Sent to the successful candidates by postal mail in October.
