3.1. President

Michael Rauchenwald confirms the nominations of two Executive Board members:

-Guy Bogaert: Treasurer 2nd term

-John Varkarakis: Chair Certification Committee 1st term

He invites all members to actively engage in, promote, and support the work of the board and its committees. Open communication is valued, and members are encouraged to share the perspectives and needs of their societies to help build a strong and successful partnership.

3.2. Accreditation Committee – report by Archil Chkhotua

The presentation deals with two topics.

- European Training Requirements (ETR) document: In conjunction with UEMS ETR Review Committee the ETR version 2025 has been updated significantly.

In terms of the ETR version 2026, further information will be shared concerning the endorsement by the national societies and how it can be implemented on a national level.

-Sub-specialty certification: The concept of subspecialty certification has been under discussion for some time. Archil Chkhotua and Carlo Bettocchi (Chair of the EAU Section of Andrological Urology) have further developed the concept by establishing criteria for subspecialisation in Andrology. The proposal will require thorough consideration by the committee, the Executive Boards of the EBU and EAU.

3.3. Certification Committee – report by Magne Dimmen

He presents an overview of certified training programmes:

-Residency Training Programme in Urology (RTPU): 68 programmes in 21 countries

-European Urology Scholarship Programme (EUSP): 58 programmes/35 centres in 12 countries.

The committee significantly revised and simplified the RTPU application form, which is expected to make the application process more accessible.

Guy Bogaert notes that, although France has multiple EUSP host centres, it does not currently have any certified RTPUs. Julien Branchereau adds that he and his co-delegate, Véronique Phé, are developing a strategy to introduce RTPU certification in France.

3.4. Examination Committee – report by Stig Müller

-The FEBU International oral exams have become increasingly popular for urologists from outside Europe. Candidates in the 2026 exams presented themselves as highly-motivated and well-prepared. Pass rates:

-India: 100%

-Egypt: 73%.

-The committee is working on cleaning up the MCQ database and considers means to further develop the FEBU revalidation/Lifelong Learning project.

3.5. Treasurer – report by Guy Bogaert

Looking back on his first term, he highlights the significant work that went into achieving a positive financial balance. Key words are defined as simplification, cost discipline and direct operational management. In collaboration with the Executive Board, he will work on strategies to enhance and sustain a strong financial position.

4. Next meeting 9-10 October 2026 in Oslo, Norway

The host of this meeting, Stig Müller, shares a short presentation about the programme.

5. Any other business

Michael Rauchenwald informs the attendees about the board meetings 2027.
